The NYC Master Plumbers Council Scholarship

The Master Plumbers Council of the City of New York (NYCMPC) has established an annual Scholarship Award to honor and further the education of worthy students as selected by its Scholarship Committee. The Award program is divided into two levels: ***High School (Grades 9 – 12); and College/Post High School.***

In order to be eligible for this scholarship award, the applicant must be either:

- (a) The child or grandchild of a NYC licensed master plumber who has been a member in good standing of the NYCMPC for a minimum of one (1) year preceding the application date, or a child or grandchild of a deceased member who met such membership requirement; or,
- (b) The child or grandchild of an employee who has been employed for a minimum of one (1) year by a licensed master plumber who is a member of the NYCMPC. Applicants must be sponsored by a regular member of the association.

To qualify for this award, the applicant must be:

High School – A student enrolled in a recognized public, private or denominational school in grade nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11), or twelve (12). The student must be in good standing and have maintained a scholastic average of C or better for the previous year of academic course of study preceding the date of application.

**The candidate may also have successfully completed GED equivalency.*

College/Post High School – A student in good standing already enrolled in a college, university or trade school. The student must be in good standing and have maintained a scholastic average of C or better for the previous year of academic course of study preceding the date of application.

For the **High School** and **College Awards**, preference will be given to students planning to pursue a degree in engineering or business or intend to enroll in a program specific to the plumbing or HVAC trade. Payments of the scholarship award shall be made directly to the student. The funds will not be payable if student does not enroll. To be eligible for the award, applicants must complete an application form each year and present a new essay and letters of recommendation. College applicants that have submitted two (2) letters of recommendation for the prior year, may waive the requirement for the second year of application.

2019 NYC Master Plumbers Council Scholarship

Article 1: Purpose

Section 1.1 The Master Plumbers Council of the City of New York (NYCMPC) hereby establishes an annual Scholarship Award to honor and further the education of worthy students as selected by its Scholarship Committee pursuant to the following guidelines.

Section 1.2 This Scholarship Award shall be known as the NYC Master Plumbers Council Scholarship Award. Awards in 2019 will be \$1,250 for High School recipient(s); \$2,500 for College recipient(s).

Article 2: Eligibility

Section 2.1 To be eligible for this scholarship award, the applicant must be either:

- (a) The child or grandchild of a NYC licensed master plumber who has been a member in good standing of the NYCMPC for a minimum of one (1) year preceding the application date, or a child or grandchild of a deceased member who met the membership requirement; or,
- (b) The child or grandchild of an employee who has been employed for a minimum of one (1) year by a licensed master plumber who is a member of the NYCMPC. Applicants must be sponsored by a regular member of the association.

Article 3: Scholarship Requirements

Section 3.1 To qualify for a ***High School Award***, a student must either be enrolled in a recognized public, private or denominational school in grade nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11), or twelve (12). The student must be in good standing and have maintained a scholastic average of C or better for the previous year of academic course of study preceding the date of application; or the candidate must have successfully completed GED equivalency.

Section 3.2 To qualify for a ***College Award***, a student must be already enrolled in a college, university or trade school. The student must be in good standing and have maintained a scholastic average of C or better for the previous year of academic course of study preceding the date of application.

Section 3.3 For high school and college awards, the applicant must furnish two (2) letters of recommendation (preferably on official letterhead), signed and in writing certifying as to scholastic ability, character and worthiness to receive this financial award. College applicants that have submitted two (2) letters for the prior year may waive the requirement for the second year of application.

Section 3.4 For the high school and college awards, preference will be given to students planning to pursue a degree in engineering or business or intend to enroll in a program specific to the plumbing or HVAC trade. Graduate students must be pursuing a career related to the plumbing-heating-cooling industry.

Section 3.5 The number of scholarships that shall be awarded annually will be determined by the Scholarship Committee.

Article 4: Applications

Section 4.1 Any qualified high school or college applicant shall have submitted to the NYCMPC office, **postmarked on or before Friday, April 12, 2019**, the following materials:

- A letter of application to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee, written by the applicant
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (see section 3 above)
- Transcript of scholastic record for the preceding year
- A 500 Word Essay
- Completed Application Form
- List of accomplishments/activities, leadership and awards.
- Signed affidavit/letter that award received must be used in upcoming 12-month school year (given to award winner[s] only)

Article 5: Award

Section 5.1 Following the receipt of applications, the Scholarship Committee shall meet for the purpose of passing upon the applications and shall decide the recipient(s) of the scholarship award. The following factors will be taken into consideration when making a decision:

- Academic Achievements
- Leadership/Work Experience
- Essay
- Worthiness

If the Committee chooses, it may ask all or some of the applicants to appear for personal interviews.

Section 5.2 On determining the recipient(s) of the award, the Scholarship Committee shall notify the NYCMPC Board of Directors of its decision and the chairman of the committee shall thereupon notify the recipient(s) of their award.

Article 6: Conditions

Section 6.1 Scholarship payments for high school and college students shall be made directly to the student. The funds will not be payable if the student does not enroll in an educational institution.

Article 7: General

The right to reject any and all award applicants is the sole discretion of the NYCMPC and Scholarship Committee.
